As **Director of Global Health at RTI International**, Dr. Rouse manages research programs involving RTI's diverse disciplines to address major global health needs. Dr. Rouse is the principal investigator of a program at RTI supported by the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases to link public and private sectors to make available new treatments for tuberculosis.

Dr. Rouse has made important contributions in the formation and activities of the **Global Alliance for Tuberculosis Drug Development**, an international public-private partnership to develop new drugs for tuberculosis, also known as the TB Alliance.
