The Italian studies minor involves coursework in Italian language, culture, and civilization. Eighteen (18) hours of coursework above the 100-level are required. For courses above the 100-level, students may take Intermediate-level courses at Meredith, or Intermediate and advanced-level courses at NCSU, through study abroad, or other courses with prior approval.
