One way that Meredith College demonstrates its commitment to supporting North Carolina schools and teachers is by offering tuition assistance for the Master of Education Program. Working teachers can receive \$200 credit for each three-credit course they are enrolled in at Meredith College.

To qualify, you must:

1. Be a degree candidate in the Master of Education Program. Students enrolled for licensure-only are not eligible.
2. Be under contract in a public or private North Carolina school, on the elementary, middle, or secondary level.
3. Provide verification of employment by the principal of your school.

For fall and spring semesters, one-half of the total tuition is due at registration; the grant will be credited in the mid-semester billing. For summer, the total tuition is due at registration; if you qualify for the assistance, you may deduct the correct amount when you pay. *This verification is valid for fall, spring, and summer semesters and must be renewed each fall semester you are enrolled.*
