2. To provide a developmentally appropriate program for infants and toddlers from birth to age two within the context of a large child care home.

4. To provide a setting for child development research that members of the Child Development Faculty at Meredith College have approved.
5. To provide a model facility for programs and agencies concerned about childcare, and to serve as a resource of information to those interested in establishing quality childcare facilities.
