What you need to know

Important Dates:

Transfer/Adult Undergraduate Students

Recommended Deadlines:

Fall semester—February 15

Spring semester—December 1

Applications submitted after these dates will be considered for admission.

Admissions decision notification occurs on a rolling basis. The admissions office will begin to accept and review fall 2012 applications in September 2011, and applications for the spring 2012 term will be accepted and reviewed beginning in June 2011.

Decisions are made within four weeks of receiving a completed application; however, the applicant should anticipate receiving communications from the Office of Admissions prior to that.

Any student who has attended another college or university is considered a transfer student. If you do not meet the criteria for transfer admission and you are age 23 or older, you may be eligible for conditional admission (23+ Program).

Please follow the instructions carefully and submit the application and fee in the envelope provided.

Requirements

Transfer Applicants

To be admitted to Meredith, the transfer student is expected to:

- have 30 or more hours of college coursework with at least 18 hours that meet General Education requirements
- have a C or higher in a college transferable math class at an accredited institution, or have completed Algebra I, II and Geometry in high school
- have at least an overall C average on all courses attempted at post-secondary institutions
- be eligible to return to the last institution regularly attended in good standing and be recommended by college officials.

An applicant having fewer than 30 semester hours of transferable college credit at the time of application must also meet freshman admission requirements, including submitting scores on the Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT). In some instances, a student having 30 or more semester hours of college credit may be expected to meet freshman admission requirements. For instance, if she has fewer than 18 hours that meet General Education requirements at Meredith, a student's credentials would be reviewed for evidence of her secondary school course background and satisfactory scores on standardized tests of academic achievement.

Conditional Admission (23+ Program)

To receive conditional admission to Meredith College, the applicant must:

- be over 23 years of age as of the first class day of the term she wishes to enroll
- have graduated from high school or have earned a General Equivalency Diploma (GED)
- have passed Algebra I or its equivalent in high school with at least a C

or have passed a college transferable math class at an accredited institution with at least a C

- students not meeting the mathematics requirement must take a course equivalent to Algebra I or a college transferable mathematics course at an accredited institution and pass with at least a C, prior to earning admission.

Re-Admit Students

A degree-seeking student who was previously enrolled at Meredith but who did not complete the semester immediately preceding the term she wishes to enter must apply for re-admission to the College, unless returning from an approved leave of absence.

Second Baccalaureate Degree Students

Students who wish to seek a second degree should have completed their first baccalaureate degree prior to enrollment.

- professor recommendation (optional).

A complete application for conditional admission (23+ program) includes:

- \$40 non-refundable application fee or acceptable fee waiver
- official high school transcript
- GED (if applicable)
- official transcript from each college, university or other post-secondary institution you have attended, whether or not credit was earned
- information session attended or individual appointment with Admissions Office.

Your application will be reviewed once these documents have been received in our office.

A complete application for Re-Admit admission includes:

- completed and signed application form, with essay
- \$25 non-refundable application fee or acceptable fee waiver
- official transcript from each college attended since Meredith College (if applicable)
- official recommendation from college last attended since Meredith College (if applicable).

Your application will be reviewed once these documents have been received in our office. Please note that you may have to resubmit credentials if they are no longer on file with the Admissions Office.

A complete application for a Second Baccalaureate Degree admission includes:

- completed and signed application form, with essay
- \$40 non-refundable application fee or acceptable fee waiver
- official high school transcript
- GED (if applicable)
- official transcript from each college attended, whether or not credit was earned
- official recommendation (if enrolled since receiving first degree).

Your application will be reviewed once these documents have been received in our office.

Financial Aid

Meredith requires the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for all applicants who wish to receive some form of assistance. The priority deadline is February 15. Applications received after this date will be considered for assistance as funding permits. FAFSA applications are available beginning January 1 at www.FAFSA.ed.gov.

Competitive Scholarships

Meredith College is proud to acknowledge those outstanding community college scholars who have been selected for recognition in Phi Theta Kappa. No additional application is necessary, but students must provide official documentation of their induction and have achieved 60 or more hours of transferable credit prior to their enrollment at Meredith to receive consideration.

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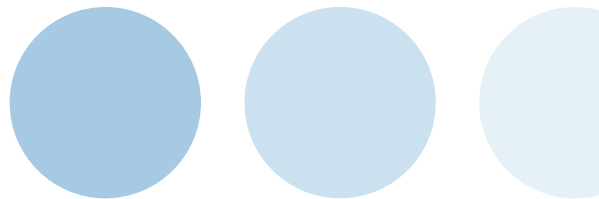

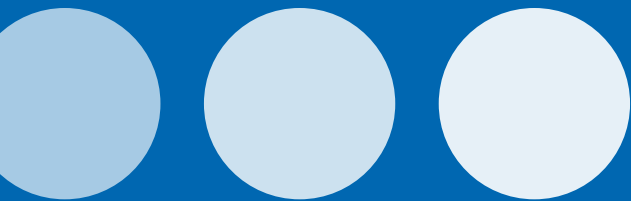
