READING DAY is a day of preparation for examinations. No instructor may schedule an exam on this day nor may any student ask to take an exam on this day.

Examination periods marked with * are for multi-sections of introductory courses in certain departments. In resolving examination conflicts, these multi-section exams take priority.

A student is considered to have an exam conflict if she is scheduled for two exams at the same time or three exams within a 24-hour period. In the case of two exams at the same time, the student and instructors should negotiate for a mutually convenient time to reschedule one of the exams. In the case of three exams during a 24 hour period, she may choose to reschedule the third exam of the three at the mutual convenience of the instructor and student unless the third exam is a multi-section exam. In that case, the second exam of the three is the one to reschedule.

There are no exams on Sunday, May 8. The last period for exams is at 1:00p.m. Friday, May 13.

Final examinations for all courses that meet during evening hours, even if the course is scheduled as a block exam, must be given during the evening.
