

Institutional Sources of Data for Comprehensive Program Assessment

Research, Planning and Assessment posts numerous reports and surveys on its website <http://www.meredith.edu/rpa2009/reports/reports.htm> and can get you individualized reports broken down by department/program, as needed, for many of these reports and surveys.

Institutional Reports include information on retention, graduation, class size, ethnic and racial enrollment, etc. For more information on institutional data, contact Lori Miller at millerlo@meredith.edu. The reports most often used for program review are:

- Declared Majors
- Declared Minors
- Enrollment reports
- Completions

Institutional Surveys can also provide useful information for program review. Meredith is currently using the following surveys:

- Cooperative Institutional Research Program (CIRP), administered to incoming students (administered annually since 1999, now alternating with BCSSE)
- Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement (BCSSE), administered to incoming students for the first time in fall 2009 (alternating with CIRP)
- National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE), administered to first year and senior students (administered annually since 2001, will be administered every 3 years starting in Spring 2012, alternating with SSI and MSL)
- Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI), administered to all students every three years (administered for the first time in 2008, will alternate with NSSE and MSL)
- Multi-institutional Study of Leadership (MSL), administered to all students every three years (administered in 2006 and 2009, will alternate with NSSE and SSI)
- Meredith Alumnae Survey, administered for the first time in spring 2009 (will alternate with Employer Survey and Faculty Survey)
- Meredith Employer Survey, administered for the first time in spring 2010 (will alternate with Employer Survey and Faculty Survey)
- Meredith Faculty Survey, administered for the first time in spring 2009 (will alternate with Alumnae Survey and Employer Survey)
