

Institutional Sources of Data for Program Review

Research, Planning and Assessment posts numerous [reports and surveys](#) on its website and can get you individualized reports broken down by department/program, as needed, for many of these reports and surveys.

Institutional Reports include information on retention, graduation, class size, ethnic and racial enrollment, etc. For more information on institutional data, contact [Lori Miller](#). The reports most often used for program review are:

- Declared Majors
- Declared Minors
- Enrollment reports
- Completions

Institutional Surveys can also provide useful information for program review. Meredith is currently using the following surveys:

- Cooperative Institutional Research Program (CIRP), administered to incoming students
- National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE), administered to first year and senior students
- Measure of Academic Proficiency and Progress (MAPP) administered to first year and junior students
- Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI), administered to all students periodically
- Multi-institutional Study of Leadership (MSL), administered to all students periodically
- Meredith Alumnae Survey, administered for the first time in spring 2009
- Before College Survey of Student Engagement (BCSSE), administered to incoming students for the first time in fall 2009 (to alternate with CIRP)
- Meredith Employer Survey, scheduled for administration in 2010
