Health and Immunization Form

A law enacted by the General Assembly of North Carolina requires all new enrollees in a college/university system to present proof of immunization prior to matriculation. Hopefully the enforcement of this law will help prevent outbreaks of dangerous communicable diseases (e.g. measles) which have been a problem on some campuses in recent years and which can be prevented if students are vaccinated adequately.

IMPORTANT: Please note that if this requirement is not met, dismissal from school 30 days after registration is mandatory under the law.

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Immunization Form (continued)

The North Carolina Legislature, as of June 1991, requires that all students must submit an up-to-date immunization record to Health Services.

This record is mandatory. If this requirement is not met, dismissal from school 30 days after registration is mandatory. Your completed immunization form must be returned to the Office of Admissions, Meredith College, 3800 Hillsborough Street, Raleigh, NC 27607-5298, by **August 1 for August registration** or **December 15 for January registration**.

We suggest that you take the immunization report form to your private physician or to your local county health department to receive the required vaccine. Appointments can be made with the Wake County Health Department for immunizations by calling (919) 250-3901, if you are a new patient, or (919) 250-3900, if you have previously received vaccines there. Your high school transcript may have immunization records that may help you. Women who have been pregnant within the last 15 years may have had a Rubella titer done by their obstetrician that we can accept.

Please do your part to make sure you have met the minimum immunization requirements before sending in your form. If you lack one or more immunizations, please obtain them with documentation before sending in our form. Your form will be returned to you if it is not complete.

If you have questions concerning this form or your immunizations, please call the Health Center at (919) 760-8535 Monday through Thursday, 8:30 a.m.-5:30 p.m. and Friday, 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

Records of immunization may be acquired from several sources.

1. High School

A copy of the immunization record maintained by the high school will probably be the easiest means of meeting the requirement. This is especially important for in-state-students.

2. Personal Shot Record

Records from pediatricians or family physicians are acceptable if verified (stamp or signature) and contain proof of minimum requirements.

3. Local Health Departments

If primary immunizations were received at a local health department, a copy can most likely be acquired from this source.

4. Transfer Students

If the college/university previously attended had immunization requirements, it is possible that these records will be acceptable proof of protection.

When you receive your health records from the above sources, take them to your physician or the health department, along with this health form, for update of immunizations according to the following requirements

A. Students born in 1957 or later and 18 years of age or older:

REQUIRED:

TD (Tetanus-Diphtheria). One TD dose must be within the last 10 years.

Rubeola (Measles). 2 doses after the first birthday.

Rubella (German Measles). 1 dose.

Mumps. 1 dose.

TB Skin test. (PPD) within one year prior to admission, or report of negative chest x-ray.

B. Students born prior to 1957.

REQUIRED:

TD (Tetanus-Diphtheria). One TD dose must be within the last 10 years.

Rubella (German Measles). 1 dose. Not required if you are 50 years of age or older.

TB Skin test. (PPD) within one year prior to admission, or report of negative chest x-ray.
