APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Instructions: Complete both sides of the application form, providing complete and accurate information. Attach a check or money order payable to “Meredith College” (do not send cash) for the \$30.00 non-refundable application fee. Return to: Paralegal Program, Meredith College, 3800 Hillsborough St., Raleigh, NC 27607.

Transcripts: Using the enclosed Transcript Request form, have the registrar at each post-secondary institution in which you have enrolled for any length of time forward an **official** copy of your transcript directly to the Program. **Electronic transcripts are NOT preferred.**

Recommendations: Using the attached Recommendation form, ask two persons familiar with your academic, employment or volunteer background to fill the form out and return directly to the Program.

Personal Statement: On a separate sheet, provide a personal statement explaining why you are interested in the law; why you are interested in the paralegal field; why you believe you are suited to the field; and what your career goals are. This statement will serve as a writing sample. It should be typed and should not exceed 500 words. If you wish, you may also submit another sample of your writing.

Current resume: List all the places of employment, dates of employment, position, and supervisor’s name. Begin with your current employment and list all full-time, part-time and summer employment. Also include the same information for volunteer experience.

Optional: Providing a photo of yourself will help to personalize your application for the staff

THE HONOR SYSTEM

A long-cherished tradition and the basis of all life at Meredith is the Honor System. Founded upon the premise that dishonesty of any nature has no place in the Meredith community, the system demands of each student personal integrity and responsible citizenship. It is the Honor System and the spirit it engenders that unite the students to form a community in which the freedom and trust essential to intellectual growth and maturity prevail.
