

Meredith faculty and staff,

In our [July 15 update on campus operations](#), we announced that Meredith administrative offices should continue operating at no more than 50% occupancy and continue with current rotations through Friday, August 7.

In order to help keep density down across campus as students return and classes resume, we are extending this decision until further notice. This extension means that staff in administrative offices who can work from home should continue doing so.

We recognize that there are many essential positions across campus whose work requires them to be on campus. We continue to be grateful for the hard work and faithful service of the individuals in these positions and believe that the decision to continue remote work to the extent possible will help protect the health and safety of all.

NC Governor Cooper is expected to make an announcement later this week about whether the state will continue to stay paused in Phase II or move into a different phase. We will update you after the Governor's announcement only if his decision has any impact on Meredith's operations.
