To the Meredith Community,

We have promised to provide regular updates on our planning process for the 2020-21 academic year. In keeping with that promise, we are writing to share several more of the key decisions we have made for the fall semester as well as to provide information on a few of the campus safety protocols we have adopted for this year.

## **Academic Updates**

In our <u>June 15</u> update, we let you know about a few changes to the academic calendar and plans to offer a well-thought out mix of instructional options. Although students will have the ability to take a full schedule of classes remotely if they wish to do so, it is important to note that some classes may not be available remotely. Information regarding the method of instruction for individual courses will be made available in July.

More details about the academic calendar, the Fall exam schedule and grading policies will be available in the coming weeks.

## **On-campus Living**

In our first Fall 2020 update to you in April, we announced our intentions to resume residential living. It is still our plan for 2020-21 to house students on campus in the residence halls and The Oaks apartments. Now that some decisions have been made about the 2020-21 academic calendar, Residence Life staff is working to solidify move-in dates and details. We anticipate that the move-in process will occur over several days with assigned time slots for individuals to help reduce the potential for crowded hallways, stairwells and elevators. Any changes in residential living options will be announced by early July.

## **Campus Safety Protocols**

Several new steps have been taken to enhance the health and safety of Meredith students, faculty, staff and the community during Covid-19. Face coverings are now required to be worn on the Meredith campus.
