

# NON-DEGREE STUDENT RESIDENCE/IMMIGRATION STATUS FORM FOR NON U.S. CITIZEN

**Instructions:** after submitting the non-degree student application for admission, review and complete the information below. Return the completed form to the Office of the Registrar by postal mail, email, or in person.

To confirm your registration for classes, non U.S. citizens must prove eligibility to study. In order to study as a part-time non-degree student you must either be a Permanent Resident of the United States, on a visa granting temporary stay, or undocumented. Please complete the form below for your appropriate status. Additional documentation may be required depending on your status.

A photocopy of the I-20 from the issuing school and I-94 card is required.
