1. READING DAY is a day of preparation for examinations. No instructor may schedule an exam on these days nor may any student ask to take an exam on these days.
2. A student is considered to have an exam conflict if she is scheduled for two exams at the same time or three exams within a 24-hour period. In the case of two exams at the same time, the student and instructors should negotiate for a mutually convenient time to reschedule one of the exams. In the case of three exams during a 24-hour period, she may choose to reschedule the third exam of the three at the mutual convenience of the instructor and student.
3. There are no exams on Sunday, May 2 and May 9. The last period for exams is at 6:00 PM on Tuesday, May 11.
4. Final examinations for all courses that meet during evening hours must be given during the evening.
5. For classes that are meeting asynchronously - final exams may be given asynchronously-or- finals may be scheduled for Saturday, May 8 at 9AM, 1PM, or 6PM. Students may have more than one asynchronous course. We are asking that you work with students who have a schedule conflict.
6. Final grades are due for ALL students on Monday, May 17 by noon.
